Cosigo Resources (CSG): Witwatersrand Gold System: Drilling is Starting



The collapse in November of the TSX Venture Index recorded an extraordinary loss of confidence in Junior Gold Stocks. From which a multi-year recovery could follow.



Typically, Great Financial Bubbles Have Been Followed by a Lengthy Rise in Gold's Real Price. We use the CRB as a proxy for mining costs and such costs declining relative to the bullion price improve profit margins.

Positioning gold stocks based on a stream of increasing earnings is investing. On the other hand, the enduring mojo of "Dollar Down, Golds Up" is not much more than advising speculation in Foreign Exchange Markets.



The "Capitulation" can be based upon analysis of Momentum and Pattern.

On a severe decline, it diminishes the problem of "Trying to Catch a Falling Knife".

At interim tops and bottoms, the "9" provides trading guidance.

In December 2023, we put together a list of "Junior" Golds and one—Cosigo (CSG) has been quiet. However, a drilling program in Colombia is now underway and the program is to test key zones in some 50kms of reef that have geological features

identifying it as another Wits System. One of which is the Conglomerate Strata with so far 17 kms of strike length identified.

Consulting geologists in SA, as well as another Wits expert outside of SA-- Quinton Hennigh--have confirmed the geology.

The following list of Juniors was assembled in December and is a practical way of participating in the Gold Sector.




Cosigo's chart has been quiet pending the start of drilling.
